



Norristown Garden Club Scholarship Rules and Information

- All Scholarships are awarded annually to college students who plan to further their education in:

Agriculture Education	Horticulture
Agronomy	Land Management
Botany	Landscape Architecture
Conservation	Plant Pathology
Environmental Concerns	And/or Related Fields
Floriculture	
- Residents** of Berks, Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery, or Philadelphia counties in Pennsylvania enrolled in full-time, horticulture-related programs are encouraged to apply. **Non-residents** will be considered if attending a full-time, horticulture-related program at an academic institution in the above Pennsylvania counties.
- Several scholarships, not less than \$2,000, are available in amounts to be determined by NGC.
- As long as high academic standing is maintained and need is apparent, a student is eligible to reapply for a scholarship for the following year.
- Scholarships will be distributed to the Financial Aid Office of the student's chosen school to be applied to the student's tuition.
- The Judging Panel uses the following formula to judge scholarship applications:

Academics	40%
Applicant's Letter, Letters of Recommendation	25%
List of Honors	10%
Financial Need	20%
Recommendation of Norristown Garden Club Member	5%
- Application must be received NO LATER THAN April 30th.**

- Official transcript of academic records including the latest grading period;
- Completed application form;
- 3 Letters of Recommendation (do not send separately);
- A typed letter (no more than one page) from the applicant stating background, special interests, personal commitment, financial need, and future goals.
